## Honoring

## Carole Harper

*Whereas*, Carole Harper of Morris Plains is being honored by the Morris County Board of County Commissioners this March 8, 2022, during Women's History Month 2022, on the occasion of her stepping down as a member of the Morris County Advisory Committee on Women, where she has served honorably for nearly two decades; and



*Whereas*, Ms. Harper was first appointed to the Committee in 2003, when it was created by what was then known as the Morris County Board of Chosen Freeholders, and she went on to help establish and focus the Committee on issues important to all women; and

*Whereas*, during her tenure, Ms. Harper helped to coordinate Morris County social services agencies to address women's issues as she encouraged women to become more involved in their communities; and

*Whereas*, Ms. Harper has had a distinguished history of leadership, serving the Planned Parenthood of Greater Northern N.J. as Chief Operating Officer, the New Jersey Nurses Association as Assistant Executive Director, the New Jersey State Board of Psychological Examiners, Morris Area Girl Scout Council, Morris County Heritage Commission, Children's Aid and Adoption Society of N.J., Maternal Health Consortium of N.J., Morris County Historical Society, and the Human Services Advisory Council of Morris County; and

*Whereas*, Ms. Harper also served on the County College of Morris Board of Trustees (CCM), including as Chair, and while she was President of the Republican Women of Morris County, she helped to establish a scholarship fund for women at CCM that has provided financial aid to women for over 20 years; and




