Application Review Process

- County Consultant reviewed 35 applications for conformance to the *Secretary of Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties*.
- Board members conducted in-person site visits.
- After a final presentation by the applicants, the Review Board deliberated on the funding recommendations.

2022 Summary of Recommendations

- The Review Board is recommending the funding of 30 projects located in 21 municipalities for a total of \$2,650,000.
- 15 of 30 projects are construction grants; the balance or 15 projects are for non-construction purposes. 83% of the funding went to construction. 17% to non-construction.
- 16 of the 30 projects received full funding.

Non-Construction Projects

- Preservation Plans are necessary in order that future preservation work associated with the structures are done in conformance with the *Standards*.
- Construction Documents allow contractor bidding and accurate construction cost estimate. Some applicants will return next year to apply for construction funding.
- We recommend funding Five (5) Preservation Plans or Condition Assessment, and Ten (10) Construction Documents to prepare coordinated drawings and specifications.
