SECURING OUR CHILDREN'S FUTURE BOND ACT

- Securing Our Children's Future Bond Act (SOCF) was approved by New Jersey voters in November 2018 to authorize grant funding supported by \$500 million in bonds.
- SOCF funding will support the expansion of CTE programs in the county vocational-technical school districts, including building, expanding, and renovating facilities.
- Projects under this grant will focus on labor market demands and further the State's economic development goals.



APPLICATION TIMELINE

NEW MORRIS COUNTY CAREER TRAINING CENTER

- **December 21, 2020:** Concept presentation to County Commissioners
- **January 21, February 2, 10, 19, 22, 2021:** Commissioners Selen/Krickus work with vocational school district on proposal for Board's consideration.
- **February 24, 2021:** Board of Commissioners approves resolution supporting application and providing 25% of capital funding and future operating expense support.
- **July 2, 2021:** NJDOE and State Legislature recommend and approve grant for \$24.8 million project (\$18.6 million state funding).
- **December 13, 2021:** Final NJDOE approval and Notice of Grant Award
- **December 14, 2021:** MCVSD Board accepts Grant Award.
- **December 22, 2021:** Board of School Estimate approves project and determines County contribution.
- **January 12, 2022:** County Commissioner Board approves capital ordinance.



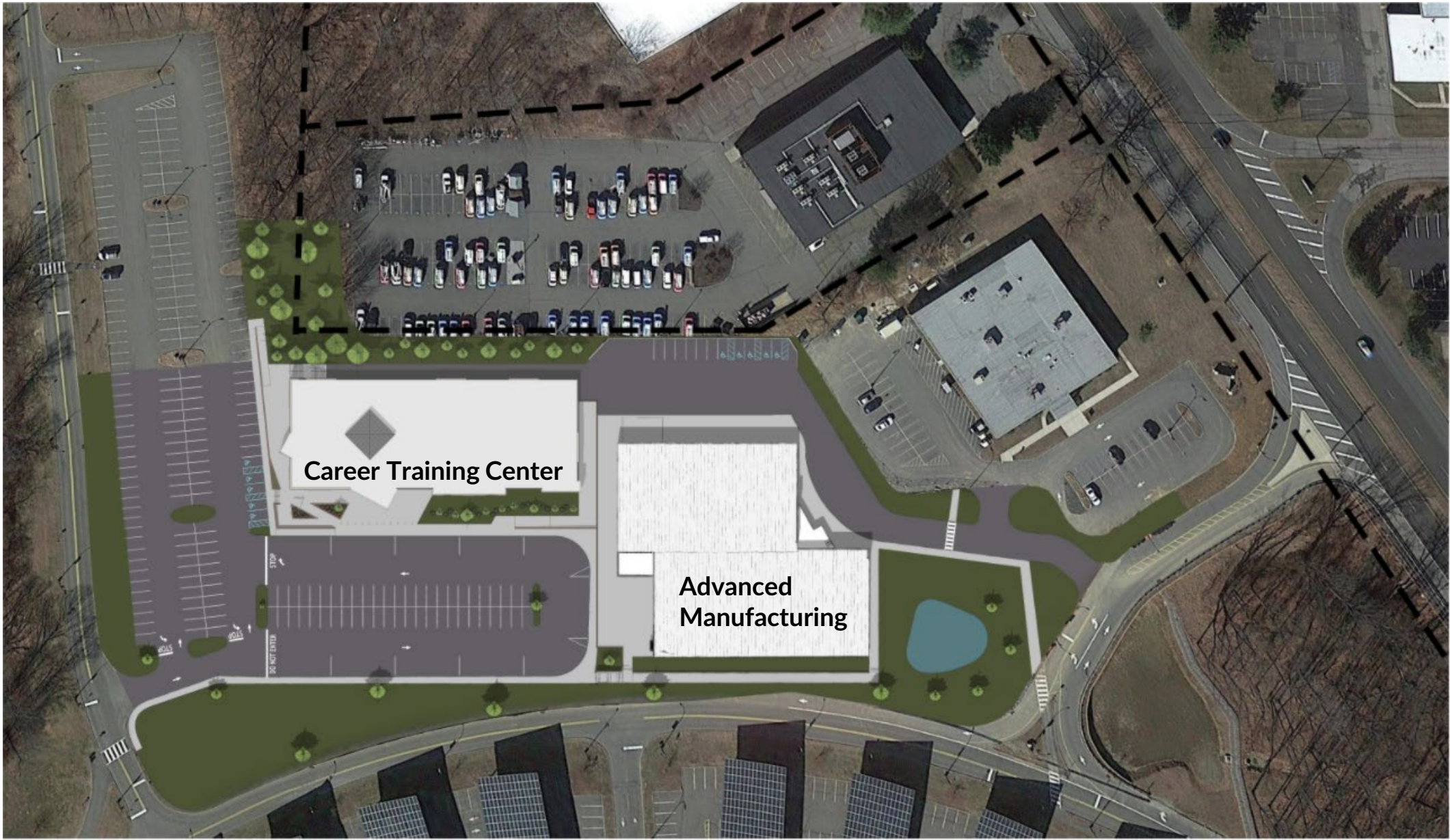
NEW MORRIS COUNTY CAREER TRAINING CENTER

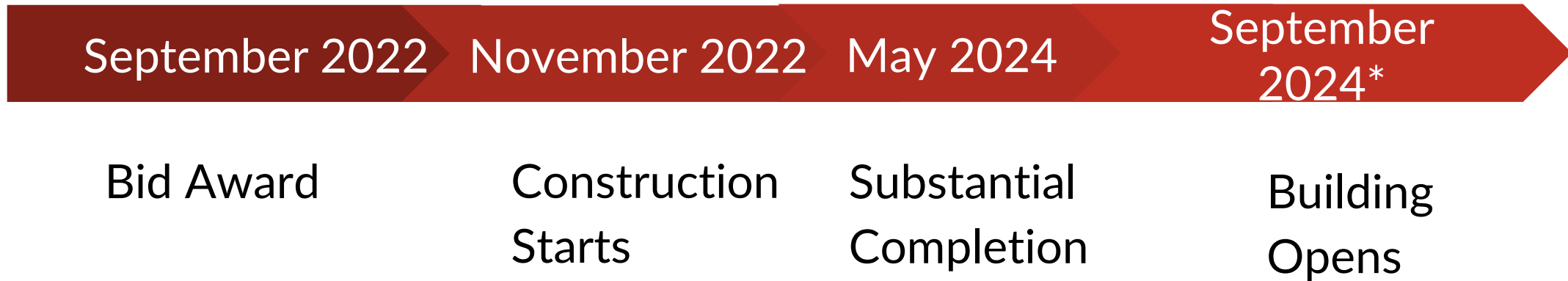








CONSTRUCTION TIMELINE

NEW CTE PROGRAMS AT CCM

- Morris County Career Training Center on CCM campus will house 10 new CTE programs for high school juniors and seniors:
 - Share-time programs (morning or afternoon)
 - Will serve an additional 500 students
 - New programs will target high demand employment industries as identified by NJ Department of Labor:
 - ✓ Health Care
 - ✓ Finance
 - ✓ Information Technology
 - ✓ Manufacturing
 - ✓ Construction/Energy (Renewable Energy Technologies)
 - ✓ Transportation, Distribution & Logistics
- Modeled after established share-time programs at CCM (EDAM, Cybersecurity, and Culinary Arts)

PROGRAM BENEFITS

- The programs will offer students:
 - Industry-Recognized Credentials
 - Work-Based Learning Opportunities
 - Project-Based Learning
 - Real-World Contact
 - Opportunity to earn up to 18 college credits per year (dual enrollment)
 - Access to technologies and opportunities not available at their home high school
- Students will have access to apprenticeships.
- Students will be able to either enter the workforce or continue their postsecondary education by transitioning into an associate's degree program at CCM.
- Students will also have the option of attending a four-year college when they have completed high school.
