Built in 1919 as the Palace Theatre, the building is is an excellent example of a vernacular interpretation of a grand era in theater design, at a time when live productions were "sharing the stage" with the fledgling movie industry. The building is also significant as an early example of the use of concrete construction in theaters and in its rare use of drapery as a decorative ceiling treatment. Currently utilized as the Growing Stage Theatre for Young Audiences, it is individually listed in both the New Jersey and National Registers of Historic Places.

A Preservation Plan was completed with a 2006 grant.

The 2008 and 2010 grants provided for the restoration and rehabilitation of the front façade, front entrance, two former storefronts, marquee and building cornice.

The 2015 and 2017 grants provided for the exterior restoration of the building including structural upgrades of roof framing, and roof replacement.

The 2019 and 2020 grants assisted with the restoration of the theater fly system including the removal of existing ceiling in the fly tower and construction of a new structural ceiling, and the purchase and installation of a new fly system.

The 2022 grant completed Construction Documents for structural upgrades at the stage, replacement of the stage flooring, and exterior lighting.

The 2023 grant will assist with stage and circulation upgrades including structural upgrades, new circular stair, installation of new stage floor and stage trap door.

The 2024 grant is providing for the completion of Construction Documents related to new mechanical systems.
